PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Burt led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Alderman Nelson asked to Table the discussion for Multi-family/Apartment "R-3" Ordinance until a time Alderman Schneider can attend. Alderman Nelson made a motion, seconded by Alderman Karrenbrock to approve the agenda with tabling Item#2 – Old Business from the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Alderman Nelson made a motion, seconded by Alderman Goodman to approve the minutes of August 13, 2024, Regular Meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

Alderman Karrenbrock made a motion, seconded by Alderman Nelson to approve the minutes of August 22, 2024, Work Session. Motion passed unanimously.

OPEN FORUM

Mr. Chris Caldwell, 169 Cooperwyck, reported the water seepage problem at the new Fire Station has no above ground water at this time, but it is a drought situation. PWSD#2 had tested the water for chlorine to try and determine where the water is leaking from and the results did not show any distinct amount of chlorine. Mr. Caldwell also had questions for the Board and Cochran Engineering about the design for the Foristell Rd. Trail: will golf carts be allowed? Can the design be changed to have the trail on the same side as the library instead of the Sycamore Creek side and then have only (1) one crossing of State Hwy Z instead of (2) two. It would be a safer route to use Fiddlestix HOA property for access to Boone Trail Library. Also – the future

may allow for a stoplight at Hwy Z and Foristell Rd. and sidewalk crossings would already be in place.

Mr. Sam Cummins, 3640 Schutzen St., brought to the Board the issues of storm water management on his property. 1) is there a city easement at the location of where the storm water currently drains. 2) will the proposed road improvements on Mill St. impact his property and storm water runoff. 3) There is increasing damage from the Peter St. water flow as when there is a heavy rain the water flows around the pipe crossing and is eroding.

Ms. Tina Janitch, 120 Groenberger St., also brought to the Board the issues of storm water management. Storm water is not draining and flooding has come within feet of her home. Gravel has run onto their asphalt driveway and is ruining the driveway. None of these issues existed before the Peter St. improvement project. Will the Mill St. Improvement Project address this situation or will it make matters worse.

ENGINEERING REPORT

- 1. Kurt Daniels, Cochran Engineering, Mill St. Improvements and Schutzen St. Sidewalk Replacement easement acquisitions. 16 of the 22 easements have been acquired. Negotiations continue for Ms. Nelson, Mr. Nash, New Melle Firehouse (previous location), Straatmann Feed, Mr. Bystrom and brightspeed. Several meetings were arranged with brightspeed representatives but they have not shown up.
- 2. Preliminary plans for the Foristell Rd. Trail have been submitted to MoDOT for review. Construction is tentative for September of 2026, when funds become available.
- 3. The request for Escrow Release of Funds for the grading permit for the new fire station will be tabled at this time for further discussion.
- 4. The storm water runoff issues for Peter St. residents continues to be reviewed. Some of the problems are with property owners not complying with code enforcement to remove brush/vegetation from the drainage areas. Energy dissipation of the water direction was considered in the Peter St. plan but it is the responsibility of the property owners to keep the channel clear.

BUILDING/PERMIT REPORT

- 1. Land Use Permit Pending for American Data for the new PWSD#2 pump station
- 2. New construction at 140 Almeling St. is approved.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1. The city received three bids for replacing the damaged entrance ramp to city hall. The Board will table the decision for bid award for further review.
- 2. Discussion regarding "R-3" Zoning is tabled until another time.
- 3. The city will look at comparable salaries for a part-time code enforcement officer to address the complaints of code violations.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Review of revisions/removal of the current Firearms Ordinance will continue at the next BOA Meeting. The Mayor and Board of Aldermen would like more time to review options for the ordinance.
